4. Payments

Payment for follow-up appointments will be taken at the Clinic, immediately after completion of the appointment. In clinic payment can be made by the above credit or debit cards or by cash.

5. Right to cancel

Appointments booked online may be cancelled up to 24 hours prior to the appointment time and a full refund of treatment fees paid will be issued by the Clinic. Appointments cancelled within 24 hours of the appointment may be liable to a cancellation charge up to the full cost of the treatment.
